BIOGRAPHY

Born in Luxembourg in 1975, Guillaume Le Grontec began in photography at the age of 16. Then he quickly became interested in the moving image, in particular through contemporary dance films, leading him to reflect on the rhythm of the image and its editing, and nourishing its artistic sensibility.

Living between New York and Paris for several years, Guillaume has met very different directors and artists on various French and international projects.

He provides his know-how both in music videos and in advertising, with directors such as Romain Quirot, Philip R Lopez, Hugues de la Brosse, David Tomaszewski, Guillaume Cagniard, Colin Solal Cardo, Lars Blumers, or Daniel Wirtberg, by working with production companies such as Birth, Superette, Slang, Big, Solab, Quad, Les Fils de or La Petite Reine.

After a first short film in 2009, Brune Renault, by the visual artist Neil Beloufa, Guillaume embarked on fiction and goes on with ten other films (short and feature films), notably Ni oui, by

Jean -François Fontanel, short film which won him a prize at the Festival des Saisons Parisiennes, St Petersburg (2013), Tonight and the people, feature film by Neil Beloufa, Wrinkles of the City - Istanbul, short project by the artist JR directed by Guillaume Cagnard, Lovebirds short film by Martin Garde Abildgaard, Occidental, feature film by Neil Beloufa for which Guillaume's work was particularly noted, Matador short film by Matthias Jenny, Personae short film by Rémy Rondeau, up to the multi-awarded short The Van by Erenik Beqiri, part of the official competition at Cannes Film Festival in 2019 and for which Guillaume received the special mention at the 40th Manaki Brothers International Cinematographers' film Festival, and the prize for best photography at the Social World Film Festival of Vico Equense in Italy.

His latest short film collaboration, *A Short Trip*, directed by Erenik Beqiri, was awarded the Orizzonti Prize for Best Short Film at the 2023 Venice Film Festival.

BIOGRAPHIE

Né au Luxembourg en 1975, Guillaume Le Grontec débute en photographie dès l'âge de 16 ans puis s'intéresse rapidement à l'image-mouvement, par le biais notamment de films de danse contemporaine, le menant à réfléchir sur le rythme de l'image et son montage, et nourrissant sa sensibilité artistique.

Ayant vécu entre New York et Paris pendant plusieurs années, Guillaume a été amené à rencontrer des réalisateurs et artistes très différents, sur des projets français et internationaux variés.

Il met à disposition son savoir-faire aussi bien en clip qu'en publicité, avec des réalisateurs tels que Romain Quirot, Philip R Lopez, Hugues de la Brosse, David Tomaszewski, Guillaume Cagniard, Colin Solal Cardo, Lars Blumers, ou Daniel Wirtberg, en travaillant avec des sociétés de production comme Birth, Superette, Slang, Big, Solab, Quad, Les Fils de ou encore La Petite Reine.

Après un premier court métrage en 2009, Brune Renault, de l'artiste plasticien Neil Beloufa, Guillaume se lance dans la fiction et enchaîne avec une dizaine d'autres films (courts et longs métrages), notamment Ni oui, de Jean-François Fontanel, court-métrage qui lui vaut un prix au Festival des Saisons Parisiennes de St Petersburg (2013), Tonight and the people, long métrage de Neil Beloufa, Wrinkles of the City – Istanbul, projet court de l'artiste J.R réalisé par Guillaume Cagnard, Lovebirds court-métrage de Martin Garde Abildgaard, Occidental long métrage de Neil Beloufa pour lequel le travail de Guillaume a été particulièrement remarqué, Matador court-métrage de Matthias Jenny, Personae court-métrage de Rémy Rondeau, jusqu'au court multiprimé The Van de Erenik Beqiri, en compétition officielle à Cannes en 2019 et pour lequel Guillaume a reçu la mention spéciale au 40ème Festival international des directeurs de la photographie des frères Manaki, et le prix de la meilleure photographie au Social World Film Festival de Vico Equense en Italie.

Sa dernière collaboration en court-métrage, *A Short Trip*, réalisé par Erenik Beqiri, a été récompensé du Prix Orizzonti du Meilleur Court-Métrage à la Mostra de Venise 2023.
